## FREE Safeguarding eLearning

**Safeguarding Bedfordshire offers free eLearning to practitioners in statutory, independent and voluntary agencies delivering services to children, young people and adults in Bedfordshire.**

**Our eLearning offer has been updated and now includes three levels of core safeguarding training. Choose from Safeguarding Children, Safeguarding Adults or Safeguarding Everybody if you work across both areas.**

### **LEVEL 1 Safeguarding Children/ Adults/ Everyone \*NEW\***

***Suitable for:** This Level 1 course is suitable for a range of roles who need to be able to recognise and report suspected signs of abuse involving vulnerable children. Roles may include: Receptionists, Administrators, Caterers, Transport staff, Maintenance staff, Governors, Volunteers.*

This course offers an awareness of signs/ indicators of abuse helping you to safeguard whilst carrying out your duties. Level 1 eLearning is aimed at those new to role and/ or those needing an awareness of signs/ indicators of abuse and what to do with concerns. *(Safeguarding Everyone includes all Children and Adult modules and is most suited to those who work across both workforces.)*

### **LEVEL 2 Safeguarding Children/ Adults/ Everyone \*NEW\***

***Suitable for:** This Level 2 course is suitable for a range of roles which includes frequent or regular work with vulnerable groups. Roles may include: Teaching assistants, Childminders, Early Years Practitioners, Health & Social Care workers, Administrators & Reception staff.*

If you work with children young people and/ or adults, you have responsibilities to ensure that any suspected abuse or neglect is reported to the appropriate level. This course will give you the knowledge to ensure you can help safeguard not only those you are directly responsible for but everyone you have contact with whilst carrying out your duties. *(Level 2 training also includes L1 modules.)*

### **LEVEL 3 Safeguarding Children/ Adults/ Everyone \*NEW\***

***Suitable for:** Level 3 training is suitable for anyone who holds a senior/ leader/ management position and frequently works with vulnerable groups or anyone who has a designated safeguarding role. Roles may include: Teachers, Childminders, Safeguarding Governors, Doctors, Nurses, Social workers, Police.*

Being a lead worker in a safeguarding environment comes with important responsibilities. You'll need to be confident that your safeguarding is up to date and in-depth. Level 3 eLearning offers the knowledge needed to understand how to respond in safeguarding situations and helps you to apply this to your own workplace. *(Level 3 training also includes L1/ L2 modules.)*
